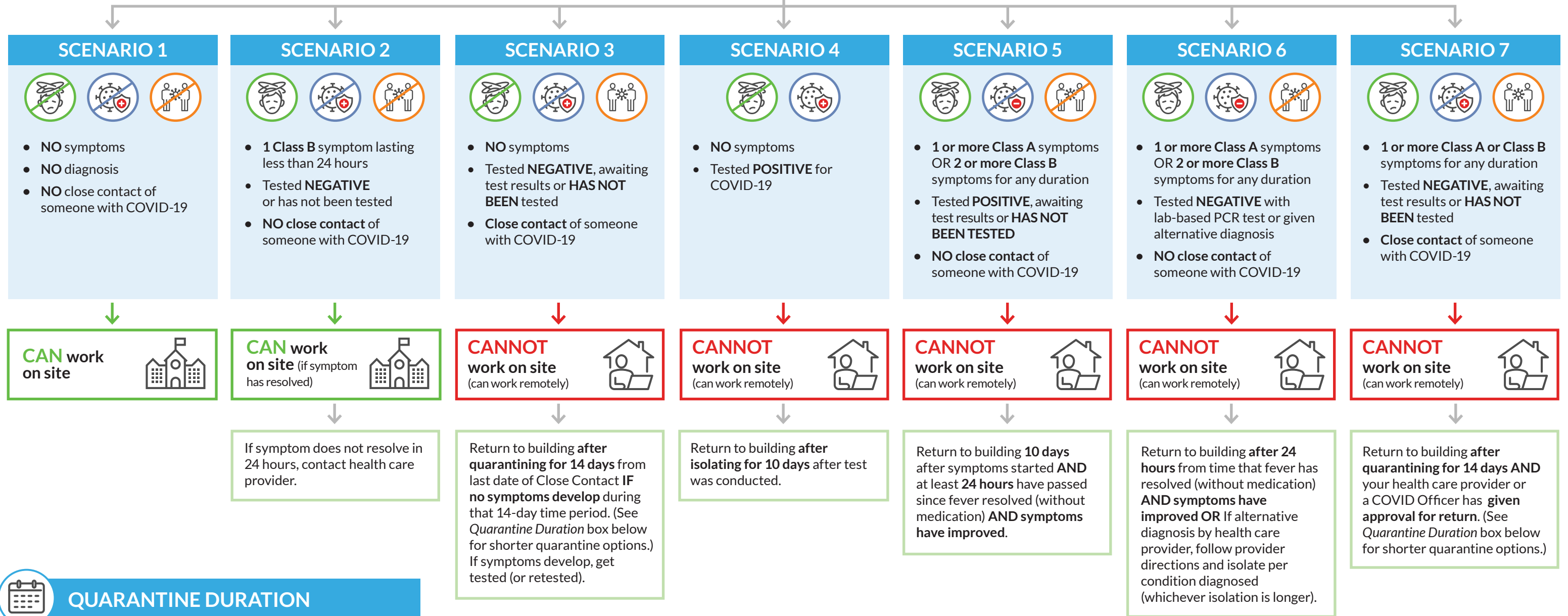


# COVID-19 Staff Symptom Flow Chart

## STAFF SELF-SCREEN FOR COVID-19



### QUARANTINE DURATION

- If recommended 14 days is not possible, these two options are acceptable alternatives:
1. If a person who is in quarantine has no symptoms, quarantine can end after Day 10.
  2. If a person who is in quarantine receives a negative COVID-19 test and has no symptoms, quarantine can end after Day 7. The person must be tested on or after Day 5, and quarantine cannot be discontinued earlier than Day 8. Even if a negative test is received before Day 8, the quarantine period should still be a full seven days.

### CLOSE CONTACTS

"Close Contact" means being within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 for about 15 minutes or more. Members of a household are considered to be close contacts.
