RE: CHILDREN WITH LIFE-THREATENING CONDITIONS

Dear Parents:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of a law enacted to help your child's school provide for the safety and health of children with life-threatening conditions.

The law defines life-threatening condition as "a health condition that will put the child in danger of death during the school day if a medication or treatment order and a nursing plan are not in place." Children with life-threatening conditions such as a severe bee sting or food allergies, severe asthma, unstable diabetes, severe seizures, etc., are required to have a medication or treatment order and nursing plan in place before they start school.

We are asking parents to help us comply with these requirements and the safety of all our students.

If a medication or treatment order is not provided, the chief administrator of the school is required to exclude the child until such order has been provided. This is for new students and for ones who have been in attendance at the school.

It is vital to your child's safety during the school day to notify our school's principal, or nurse if your child has a life-threatening health condition that may require medical services to be performed at school. The school nurse has the necessary forms to be filled out and a time can be arranged for you to meet with her.

Please return this form to your school so we may update our files for the safety of all our students.
